

Careers Related Tutor Time Sessions 2022/2023

YEAR 11 – In computer Rooms

Aim:

To provide snapshots of information to support students in years 7-11 to make informed choices about their future career and education options.

Objectives:

- **Every year group to have at least one careers focused tutor sessions each term.** *Video /Resource links provided. Tutors to facilitate follow on discussion. Year 11s to access during a computer session.*
- **Tutors to support students to write in their Careers Related Learning Logs within their planners at least once a term.** *This should be any activity they have taken part in, (in or out of school), that relates to developing employability skills or career planning. E.g. attended an assembly where I heard about a job I didn't know about, watched a video on how what I learn in maths relates to jobs, attended a college open event, spoke to an employer at the careers fair, spoke to my neighbour about their job, babysat for a family friend, did an online careers interests quiz..... etc.*
