## Swindon and Wiltshire Careers Hub Report The John of Gaunt School – September 2022





The Gatsby Foundation, in partnership with the Careers & Enterprise Company, developed the Compass evaluation tool to enable Careers Leaders to evaluate careers activity in their school or college against the eight benchmarks of best practice – known as the Gatsby Benchmarks. The most recent Compass evaluation for your school was completed in June 2022.

## **Progress Report**

The first chart below shows the percentage achievement by your school for each of the 8 Gatsby Benchmarks and, for comparison, provides national and local average scores for each benchmark. The second chart shows the percentage achievement for each benchmark across the three most recent Compass evaluations.

The DfE expects schools and colleges to achieve all eight Gatsby Benchmarks, prioritising Benchmark 1 (A stable careers programme), as this underpins the achievement of all the other benchmarks.





Your school has achieved 3 benchmarks. The current average for Swindon and Wiltshire schools as at summer 2022 is 5.58 benchmarks achieved. The national average is 4.99 benchmarks achieved.
