

Summer School August 2021

The School was pleased to facilitate the running of a summer school during August 2021 over a period of 10 days from Monday 2 August – Friday 13 August 2021. The average attendance each day was 114 students.

Students attended the site and were able to join in with a variety of different activities including transitional activities such as meeting teachers and a tour of the school, sports based activities such as team games, Arts based activities including drama, Wellbeingbased activities such as team building and getting to know you exercises. We also had other enrichment and pastoral activities which included visiting mentors.

The school spent £67,213 on the summer school and has submitted a claim to the Department for Education (DfE) for reimbursement of these costs.

Breakdown of costs £67,213:

 Activities and Co-ordination £52,406

£10,000 Use of Buildings to include Energy/Water/Cleaning etc

£4,807 - Food/Catering

£67,213 - Total Costs

The overwhelming feedback was extremely positive for the summer school and subject to continued DfE funding we may be able to run future summer school events.
