

English Baccalaureate (EBacc)

EBacc impact:

The EBacc is made up of the subjects which are considered essential to many degrees and open up lots of doors.

The government's ambition is to see 90% of pupils studying the EBacc subject combination at GCSE by 2025.

The EBacc is:

- English language and literature
- maths
- the sciences
- geography or history
- a language Spanish

"The EBacc is a set of subjects at GCSE that keeps young people's options open for further study and future careers."

No pathways but our expectations

Students aspiring to move onto sixth form and higher education

- Broad and balanced range of mainly GCSE subjects
- English Baccalaureate award: subjects that include a humanities subject and a modern foreign language

Students who are considering a further education pathway

- Broad and balanced range of GCSE and vocational equivalent courses
- Must select a humanities subject
- Some selected students will have a reduced timetable complemented with study support to ensure they are able to progress well in all their subjects.

 - A steer toward a certain breadth of subjects to keep all future pathways open
 - Matching subjects to potential capability and future aspirations, including the English Baccalaureate for higher education
