EXCELLENT ATTENDANCE

100-98%

GOOD ATTENDANCE

96-97.9%

Students have had infrequent time off of school and this is for accepted reason or has medical evidence. There are no unauthorised absences. There is a call each day when absent.

INITIAL CONCERNS

95.9-93%

Absences are regular and there are instances of mild illness absences. Absences are not often communicated. The student is missing out on school life. Medical appointments are regularly taken in school time.

CONCERNING ATTENDANCE

92.9-91%

There are instances of repeated absences, often for mild illness or similar illnesses which have not sought medical advice. An attendance contract may have been sent out and there has been support offered to help remove barriers to improve attendance.

MEDICAL APPOINTMENTS

Medical appointments are taken outside of school time or are limited to the time frame of the appointment. These are communicated in advance and pink slips are used.

PUNCTUALITY

There is little to no lateness to school or lessons and when this does occur it is for reasons outside their control i.e. bus arrivals.

OUTCOMES

Attendance is celebrated and rewards are given. Students are put into the draw and are given points for their house as well as a certificate. Positive communication is sent home.
