

UNIFORM

Dear Parents and Carers,

Our uniform policy is written to ensure our uniform best meets the needs of students and is also the best value for money. By joining us in The John of Gaunt School community we expect students to follow our policy and wear our uniform with pride, one of the ways we reflect one of the school's values, belonging.

Main Uniform

Trousers: Plain Black only; full length, to at least the top of the shoe, with no ankle showing. Made of plain material, classic tailored style with no extreme flares or skin-tight styles. No leggings, footless tights, drain pipes, cords, jeans of any sort, cropped trousers or shorts (unless noted below) are not allowed.

Skirt: Knee length John of Gaunt School skirt in dark grey plaid with twin pleats on the front and back.

Sweatshirt: Plain Black with school logo. No hooded tops / sweat shorts including ones with zips are permitted.

Socks and tights: Must be grey, black or white and plain. Must be plain dark tights which should not be worn with socks visible.

Polo Shirt: Plain white polo shirt to be tucked into trousers or skirt if worn with sweatshirt/jumper. Polo shirts with Falcon logo are now optional and may still be purchased from Scholars. Please contact Miss Lewis if you need to know your house for this prior to the information day in July.

Shorts: Plain black, tailored, knee length shorts. Permitted for terms 1 (Sept – Oct) and terms 5 and 6 (return after Easter Holiday to end of Summer term). Cycling shorts, sports shorts, shorts made from stretchy or jersey fabric and shorts which are significantly above the knee are not permitted.

Shoes: Plain black shoes or plain black trainers which are able to be polished only. They MUST NOT be fabric. All other types of footwear are not allowed including trainers with any colour other than black, even small logos or visible sort including 'Doc Martin' style boots. Daps, 'Ugg' boots, boots, open-toed sandals and decorated shoes are not allowed.

PE Kit:

Panelled grey polo shirt

Panelled grey PE short / or skort or plain black loose-fitting sports shorts (no form of tight 'cycling' style shorts),

Panelled track trouser / or leggings or plain black track trouser or leggings

Training shoes with non-marking soles

Optional panelled hooded sweatshirt (must not be worn outside of PE lessons)

Nails should be short and of a suitable length for school. Long nails, both natural and acrylic are a health and safety risk.

Jewellery: A plain signet ring and a watch may be worn. One small stud earring in each ear may be worn. A clear 'placeholder' nose stud may also be worn. All other visible jewellery will be confiscated until the end of the school day.
