### September Covid-19 testing arrangements

Further to my letter last week regarding lateral flow testing on our return to school in September, please see below details of the timings for testing for **Year 7**. As a reminder, for test one students should come in to school for their test and go home again. They will return to school on 2<sup>nd</sup> September for their induction day before starting their lessons on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup>. You are welcome to attend with them for this first test if you feel they would be more comfortable with this. Test two will be taken during the school day and students will leave their class as a group and return to lessons after the test.

I would also like to remind you that consent is required for all under 16s to be tested on site. If consent has been given previously we will take this as agreement to the planned September tests. If you have not already done so, please see below the attached link to access the online form.
