



Dear Parent / Carer

As from September, with the school day starting at 8.30 am, we have worked with Wiltshire Council to change bus timings to ensure students arrive at school in time for an 8.30 start.

Faresaver buses have agreed and supported a short change to the bus registration for bus X34. Their timetable will be available on their website shortly but in summary:

Students who have previously used bus 77 from Bulkington/Steeple Ashton and Keevil and want to arrive on time will now need to use X77.

Those farepayers at Paxcroft Mead and Horse Road should really aim to use bus X34 as this has higher seating capacity (double decker) than X77 so would suggest these pupils aim to get on whichever bus arrives first with capacity to take them.

Buses that have NOT been able to be changed are:

FirstBus D1/D1x from Bradford to Trowbridge – this will arrive at Trinity Church at about 0820 anyway.

Firstbus D1/D1x from Westbury to Trowbridge – this will arrive early at 0750 at Trinity Church

Stagecoach 49 from Devizes/Seend/Semington to Trowbridge – this bus will arrive on Bythesea Rd at 0825.

Beeline Bus 59 from Westbury/West Ashton will be re-routed through Trowbridge dropping first at JOG first before Clarendon School.

We hope this clarifies the bus situation and goes some way to alleviating any concerns before students return to school.
