

### Consent taught through PSHE, explicit and implicit lessons in every year group

Year group	Module	Content
Y7	Modules: Safeguarding – Term 1 Growing and changing - Term 5	Taught through exploration of topics – Bullying behaviour, discussion of how this is seen and how students can be forced into behaviour they are not consenting to. Positive and unwanted touching (age appropriate) how to report concerns.
Y8	Drugs education – Term 2  SRE – Term 6	When discussing alcohol and other recreational drugs, the link to risky behaviour is made and discussion of consent and the ability to give consent when under the influence of drugs and alcohol. Through explicit lessons within SRE, focus on healthy and unhealthy relationships including a lesson on domestic abuse and abuse within relationships.
Y9	Identity and equality module – Term 5  SRE – Term 6	Includes explicit lessons on harassment, equality act and managing self-identity and expression. Includes clear information on consent, sexuality and gender identity Development of sequenced learning building on Term 6 of year 8. Revisiting healthy and unhealthy relationships and consent
Y10	Healthy and unhealthy relationships – Term 5  SRE - Term 6	Health and unhealthy relationship. When to have sex. Consent and sex (specific lesson). Use of contraception, how to discuss with partner when to have sex and alternatives to express feelings. Different attitudes to sex and relationships and different lifestyles (including abstinence, same sex relationships, monogamy and sex outside of a committed relationship.
Y11	Cruel Kindness – Terms 2 and 3	What is grooming and how to identify signs, exploitation within relationships, reality of pornography. Explicit lesson on consent. Consent Lesson when to ‘Play, Pause and Stop;’ including body language, verbal and non-verbal communication.
Y12 and Y13	Through PSHE program	Lesson on FGM, explicit lesson on consent, lesson on sexual harassment and rape culture, PSHE Day – Consent, LGBT, relationships and sexual harassment.
Throughout the PSHE program external visitors may be used to support discussions relating to consent. Examples include MOTIV8 to discuss the impact of recreational drugs on sexual behaviour and risk taking, the police, the Young Person’s Independent Domestic Violence Adviser.
