Dear Parents and Carers,

RE: Mobile Phones in Schools

As a school we are really proud that we do not allow students to use mobile phones within the school. This was introduced four years ago and the feedback on this policy continues to be extremely positive from both parents and students.

It has however, recently come to my attention that there have been a few isolated occasions when students have phoned home during the school day, either in between lessons or at break and lunch time.

It is very unlikely that your child will need to phone home, however if they do, this can either be pre-arranged in order to support needs or with permission from their Head of Year's office or reception.

We would therefore ask for your support in reminding students not to phone or text you during the school day. Clearly, if we become aware of phones being used we will follow this up through the school's behaviour policy.
